MEMBERSHIP TYPES

ORDINARY - Ordinary Members are entitled to full participation in all activities of the Society, to vote, to be elected to office and to receive the publications of the Society.

ASSOCIATE - When one member of a family is already an Ordinary Member, others of that family who are 18 years of age or older may become Associate Members. They are entitled to the same privileges as Ordinary Members, except for the receipt of publications.

JUNIOR - Junior Members shall be under the age of 18 years. They are entitled to the same privileges as Ordinary Members, except to vote or be eligible to hold office (except as a Section Leader).

STUDENT - Student membership covers a person 18 years of age or older attending a full course of study and not being in full time employment. They are entitled to the same privileges as an Ordinary Member.

CORPORATE – Membership for organizations and companies.

Notes

- 1. Definition of Metropolitan All members residing inside the boundary of the Perth Metropolitan Region Planning Scheme are deemed to be Metropolitan Members for subscription purposes (which includes: City of Joondalup, City of Wanneroo, Shire of Swan, Shire of Mundaring, Shire of Kalamunda, City of Armadale, Shire of Serpentine/Jarrahdale, City of Rockingham). All other places in WA, interstate or overseas are considered to be Country Areas.
- 2. The Sidereal Times journal is delivered (in colour) by email. A \$15 per annum additional fee will apply for all types of Membership if the member chooses to receive the journal by post instead of or as well as email (Australia only, black & white only). The membership loyalty discount of 20% does not apply to this fee.
- 3. Members with 20 years or over standing receive a loyalty discount of 20%.
- 4. Annual renewal date for subscriptions is 1 July (a 3 months payment period is allowed)
- 5. Discounts for new members after 1 January or 1 May will be applied to the second financial year of membership.
